POLICIES FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ACTIVITIES

Because we are representing Jesus Christ, as well as Cornerstone, in our conversation, attire, and behavior, we ask that members follow these policies while attending Cornerstone events.

1. Parents are responsible for the behavior of their children during Cornerstone functions. Children (or parents) who behave in a manner that is out of control or damages the reputation of the group will lose the privilege of attending future functions.
 - a. Please restrain your children from running in buildings and climbing on structures that are not playground equipment.
 - b. Encourage children to demonstrate respect and listen to the tour guides, leaders, or staff members.
 - c. Show respect for property by disposing of all trash and by leaving the area as it was found.
2. Restitution for property damage caused by any student, sibling, parent, or their guests will be the sole responsibility of the person(s)/family causing the damage and not Cornerstone Homeschool Covering. This applies to all venues for official Cornerstone events: church facilities, homes of members, field trip locations, library, or any other location used for an official Cornerstone event.
3. The use of alcohol or tobacco is not allowed at any Cornerstone function.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. Family is currently homeschooling at least one child.
2. Family agrees to abide by all policies governing Cornerstone Homeschool Covering.
3. Family is in full agreement with Cornerstone Statement of Faith.
4. Payment of annual membership dues.
5. Student participates in yearly testing.
